Corporate income tax receipts short \$3.3 million, pulling down monthly total

April 30, 2015

TOPEKA – Revenue receipts for April were \$4.4 million below expectations Thursday driven mostly by lower than expected corporate income tax receipts.

Corporate income tax receipts were \$3.3 million less than estimates.

Sales tax receipts were \$330,000 more than expected, bucking the national trend where sales had dipped down.

While individual income tax receipts were \$248,000 less than expected or 0.1 percent, the state collected \$4 million more in individual income tax receipts compared to the prior fiscal year.

"A significant amount of tax-related mail that remains to be opened, in part because of a great than expected surge of mail shortly after April 15," said Revenue Secretary Nick Jordan.
