Please make sure that you download ALL the information for your county. There are some situations where a county may have 2 or even 3 pages of Ag Values.

Please update your CALP tables XXX243 version LND, to reflect the changes in land values from 1999 to 2000.

**Reminder for those counties who receive irrigated land values:**

- There could be times when the irrigated values, when adjusted by the water ratio table, fall below the corresponding dryland value for that soil. This circumstance is not new, please take the necessary steps to ensure that irrigated land values do not fall below the corresponding dryland values.
- The 2000 Water Ratio Table is identical to the 1999 Water Ratio Table for your county. Please continue to use the modifications outlined in the 1999 version.

At this time we are in the process of scheduling educational meetings. At these meetings we will provide and explain the supporting documentation and data used to calculate the 2000 Ag Use Values.
