I strongly urge you to place the Handbook into a 3-ring binder and make sure that your members who are conducting the bingo games for your organization are familiar with it. From time to time we will send to you updated or new pages for this Handbook. Changes to the text will be highlighted on updated pages. Please make sure that these updated or new pages are inserted in the proper place in the Handbook.

Section I contains the substance of the laws, rules and regulations, including interpretations and clarifications, which apply to organizations. It is arranged by subject matter in a format that is hopefully easy to read. Section II deals with registered premises and Section III deals with registered distributors. If you conduct your bingo games at a registered premises, you should also review Section II so that you know what is expected of your premises operator. Appendix C contains the actual bingo laws as contained in the statute books. Section D contains the official bingo rules and regulations which supplement the laws. Please consult the Table of Contents to find information on specific subjects.
