

Dear Kansas Alcoholic Liquor Licensee/Permittee:

In 2001, the Kansas Legislature amended K.S.A. 41-313(b). The amended law requires non-resident applicants applying for a license or permit to file with the Secretary of State of Kansas its irrevocable written consent that any action or garnishment proceeding may be commenced against the applicant in the courts of this state by service of process on the resident agent.

You will find enclosed with this letter an Irrevocable Consent to Jurisdiction form ABC-160. Please complete this form, attach a copy of this letter to the completed form and mail to:

A copy of the Irrevocable Consent to Jurisdiction form that has been certified by the Secretary of State must be provided to the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC). The Office of the Secretary of State will **NOT** forward the copy to ABC; therefore, it is your responsibility to provide a copy to this office. The filing fee required by the Secretary of State is \$35.00. The original will be returned to you by the Office of the Secretary of State. The fee for **an additional file stamped copy** of the Irrevocable Consent to Jurisdiction form is \$1.00. Please enclose your request for copies along with the appropriate amount, made payable to Kansas Secretary of State, when you submit the completed form to the Secretary of State.

Upon receipt of the copy(ies) from the Secretary of State, please mail or fax a copy with this letter and a copy of the file stamped Irrevocable Consent to Jurisdiction to:

By making application for a liquor license or permit from the state of Kansas pursuant to K.S.A. 41-313(b), applicant irrevocably consents, as a condition precedent to obtaining a liquor license or permit, that any action or garnishment proceeding may be commenced against applicant in the courts of this state by service of process on the resident agent specified in K.S.A. 41-313(a) of this section; and applicant stipulates and agrees that such service shall be taken and held in all courts to be as valid and bring as if due service had been made upon the applicant.
2. Applicant stipulates, agrees and consents that the courts of this state have jurisdiction over applicant and are the proper and convenient forum for any action commenced against applicant.
3. Applicant waives the right to request a change of jurisdiction or venue to a court outside this state and stipulates, agrees and consents that all actions arising under the Kansas Liquor Control Act (K.S.A. 41-101 et seq.) and commenced by the applicant shall be brought in this state as the proper and convenient forum.
