Driver's license services temporarily relocated because of fires

TOPEKA—Driver's License services for Montgomery County will be moved temporarily to Fredonia for the safety of KDOR customers and staff after several intentionally set fires in the Independence Corporate Office building.

The location for driver's license and ID services in Fredonia is in the Wilson County Courthouse at 615 Madison St.

"The safety of our staff and customers comes first," Director of Vehicle Services David Harper said. "We appreciate the public bearing with us as we transition to a new Independence office soon."

Plans to move driver's license services to another office location in Independence were already underway and unrelated to the fires in the building. The location of the new office will be announced in the coming weeks.

Driver's license services will be offered in Fredonia 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday-Friday until further notice. Because of technology limitations, only paper driving tests will be offered.

Police and fire officials are investigating the fires.
