KOLAR is a web-based system designed to simplify the regulatory aspects of the oil and gas industry in Kansas by providing a system for electronic filing. KOLAR is a joint initiative that includes the Kansas Geological Survey, Kansas Department of Revenue (KDOR), Kansas Corporation Commission and Kansas County Appraisers.
