FOOD SALES TAX RATE REDUCTION

(OCTOBER 24, 2023)

During the 2022 Legislative Session House Bill 2106 was passed and signed into law. New Section 1 of the Bill, now K.S.A. 79-3603d, provides that, starting on January 1, 2023, the state sales tax rate on food and food ingredients will be reduced to 4.0%. Starting on January 1, 2024, the state sales tax rate will be reduced to 2.0%. And, starting on January 1, 2025, the state sales tax rate will be reduced to 0.0%.

Retailers making sales of food and food ingredients should note the state sales tax rate reduction from 4% to 2% that starts January 1, 2024, and make any necessary changes to their point-of-sale systems and other record keeping to properly charge the new rate. Please note the local sales tax rate in effect does not change.
